MATELEC Forum:

It will also be the scene of the Young Installers Competition, which, in its 17th year, will bring together more than 41 young participants from across the country, who will compete for the title of Best Nobel Installer. This auditorium will be located in Hall 8.

KNX Forum:

This space, organised by KNX Spain, will address the key topics that are redefining the industry, from the Internet of Things (IoT) to artificial intelligence applied to energy efficiency in buildings, making this forum a unique
